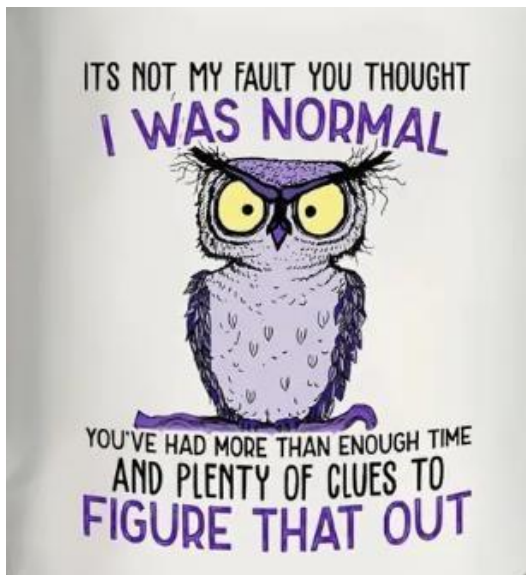

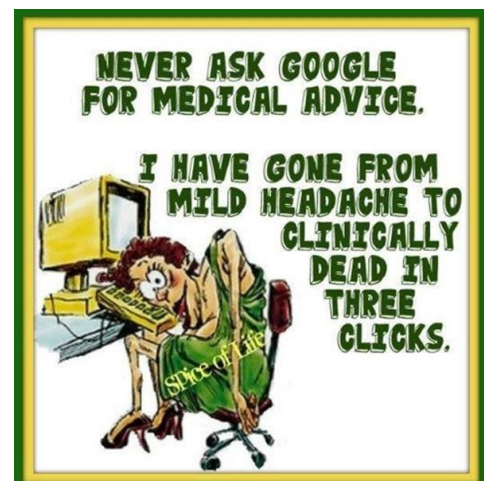


PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE JULY 2024
